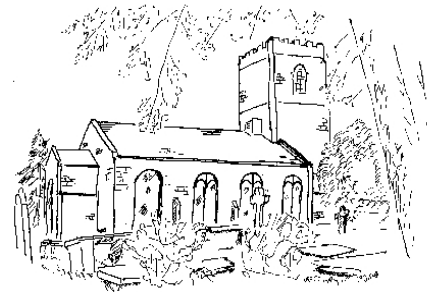

This year we commemorate the 100th anniversary of the end of WW1

At 6am a piper will play on the Village Green.

At 9.30am the Remembrance Service will be held in church ending with the roll call at the war memorial.

Bacon or sausage rolls will be served in The Mews following the service for a small charge of £2
We will gather again at 6.30pm for prayers and at 6.55pm a Bugler will play the Last Post followed by the lighting of the brazier at 7pm
The chimes will be rung by a team of volunteers at 7.10pm.
